Stiefel Vetcare Salbenspray is a spray-on salve for first-aid treatment of skin injuries. It is anti-inflammatory and can be used to help treat mud fever sores and chafe wounds. It contains arnica, oregano, thyme, chamomile, and tea tree oil which, in combination with zinc and vitamin E, can support the healing process.

Contents according to INCI:

Butane; Propane; Zinc Oxide; Isobutane; Calcium Stearate; Bisabolol; Melaleuca Alternifolia Leaf; Carvacrol Glycine Soja Oil; Arnica Montana Flower Extract; P-Cymene; Alpha-Pinenes; Myrcene; Alpha-Terpinene; Linalool. Thymol; D-Limonene; Tocopherol

Application:

Apply Vetcare Salbenspray to affected areas as needed. Shake well before using. Spray evenly on wound areas from a distance of 20–30 cm. When using on nervous animals, shake container outside of their hearing range; begin spraying gently.

Hazard note:

Extremely flammable aerosol. Pressurised container: May burst if exposed to heat. May cause skin irritations. May cause drowsiness or dizziness. Toxic for water organisms, with long-term effects.



Safety information:

Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames or other ignition sources. Do not smoke whilst applying. Do not spray in the direction of open flame or other ignition sources.

Do not puncture or burn spray can even when empty. Avoid release into the environment. Collect spilled amounts. Avoid exposure to direct sunlight. Do not expose to temperatures above 50 °C/122 °F.

Storage note :

Only for external use. Store care products in a cool and dry place protected from direct sunlight. Store out of reach of children. Contains tea tree oil, carvacrol. May cause allergic reactions. Contains hydrocarbons, C6-C7, n-alkanes, isoalkanes, cyclens, < 5% h-hexane
